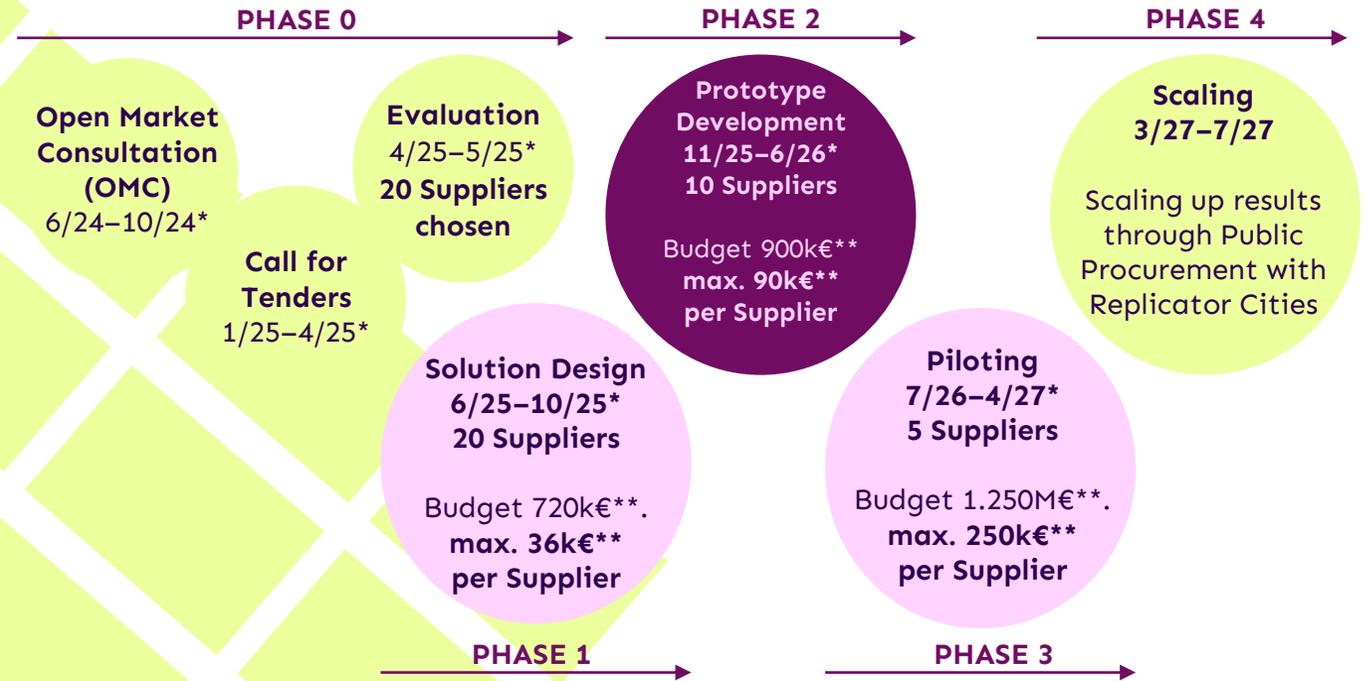
**Timeline: February '24 to July '27**

**Piloting in 5 Buyers' Group cities '26-'27.**

Smaller pilots in 10 Replicator cities.

**Budget: 5.2 M€, incl. 2.87M€ for Suppliers.**

Max. funding per Supplier: 390k€

# Three SPACE4Cities Challenges

**Objective** of solving presented Challenges is enabling European cities to manage urban spaces dynamically over time utilising satellite data.

**Suppliers are required to use Copernicus EO and/or Galileo GNSS data/services** as part of their proposed solutions.

**Buyers' Group cities offer local & national open data sources to be used by Suppliers.** More specific satellite data from ESA and EUSPA being negotiated.

# Benefits of Pre-Commercial Procurement

- **Early close collaboration with public authorities**
  - Development of solutions towards concrete public sector needs.
  - Address future European markets.
- **R&D Funding** up to 376k€ per Supplier; **lower investment** needed to generate new market opportunities.
  - **Risks shared** between Suppliers and Procurers.
  - New opportunities through **collaboration/competition with other Suppliers.**
- **Supported field testing opportunities which can be referenced** for further commercialization.
  - Support on solution development during the project.
  - Commercialization opportunities beyond the project.
- **IPRs** generated in the project are **retained by Supplier**; such as solution, data and results IPRs.
  - The Buyers' Group has the right to access and exploit the results on a royalty-free basis (Tender Document 3, Chapter 7) (tailor-made agreements after end of project - no fixed model)

# General Information about Call for Tenders

## Submission instructions on the website

- Please ensure that your submission is complete and on time!

**Who can apply:** companies, research organisation, non-profit organisations

- Must commit to goals related to commercial and scaling potential
- Must be based in the EU or Horizon Europe Associated Countries
- **Tenderers can submit a Tender alone or as part of a consortium**

**A single entity can submit multiple Tenders** (alone or in Consortia)

- Solutions must be different. Tenderer must prove their capability to deliver the work and that the same work is not charged multiple times
